New Public Management that occurred in the 1980s and 1990s From 2000 there was a discernible trend towards an emerging model variously termed the "new public service", the "new public governance" or the "post-New Public Management" (Dunleavy and Hood, 1994; Denhardt and Denhardt, 2000; Osborne, 2006)
